Judging Seminar and AGM

The next big event for the National Cavy Club is the 2018 Judging Seminar and AGM,

To be held at St Peters Community Centre, Storer Road, Loughborough, LE11 5EQ

The National Cavy Club recognises the importance of judges maintaining their knowledge and keeping up to date with changes.

This year, we have planned three seminar sessions, and have secured the services of a number of breeders, judges and exhibitors to share their knowledge and experience.

Session 1

Rex Matthews will lead a presentation on the Rex and Teddy Cavy, with opportunities for hands-on tutorials about these two popular breeds.

Session 2

Bryan Mayoh, Chairman of the British Cavy Council (BCC), will explain and clarify the inner workings and objectives of the BCC: how breed standards are created and revised, how the merits of a new variety are appraised, and how breeds progress from Assessment Classes right through to Full Standards.

Session 3

David Oulton will, with the aid of visual materials, provide a recap on those faults and disqualifications that are common to all breeds, such as hem ears, coat faults, fatty eye, side whiskers and serious physical abnormalities.

All National CC judges are expected to attend at least one judging seminar in a two year period and this training day will be an opportunity for them to fulfil their commitment.

However, the event will also be of interest to all our members, whether or not they have an ambition to judge in the future, and we would be pleased to welcome as many members as possible.

Attendance at the seminar is free for National Cavy Club members, however there will be a buffet provided for lunch at the cost of £7.50.
